## MEMBERSHIP REGULATIONS

We messed up in the Feb newsletter, on page 8. We've changed the prices for becoming a member, and on the reprint, we forgot the membership Sect'y's address. Then, in March we have Senior Citizens (55 or over) butted right up against Lifetime Member (existing member 75 or older) Free.\_\_\_\_ I guess we should have left a Space between those things, because we sure got folks confused. So, before I do anything else, I'll give you an example, so there's no more confusion. It wasn't any better in March, someone has to REDO it, CORRECTLY this time. It's not that confusing, really. I hope this helps.

To join Twin State; From 6 years old, to old age.

If you were a *6 yr old*, & wanted to join, it'd be \$8.00 a year; (Independent Associate).

If your *Dad, Mom, or an adult family member* were members already, you could join with them for \$5.00 a year. You would be an (Associate Member).

And you would pay \$5.00 a year, until you reached 18.

Once you turn 18, you are then an (*Adult Member*) and would pay \$18.00 a year.

If *married*, you'd pay \$23.00 a year, and that's an (*Adult Couple*).

Once you reach 55, then you get the (*Senior's Discount*), you'll pay \$10.00 a year.

If you're still married, by then, you'll pay \$13 a year for the (*Senior couple*).

For the next 20 years, you'll keep the discounted rate until you reach 75.

Then, *God Bless you*. You're entitled to the status of a (*Lifetime Membership*). – **FREE!**

But, say a 75 year old wants to join, and he or she's not a member.

They'd have to pay for a 1 year fee to be established as a (Lifetime Member), with no further charge for membership.

Ok, Single Adult, (18 or over)=\$18.00.

Husband & Wife = \$23.00. (Or adult couple).

Your children from 6 years old, to 17, it's \$5.00 for each child. (Associate member).

If the neighbor kid likes to go to the races, and wants to join, it's \$8.00 for him or her. \*\*\*

\*\*\*(A newsletter would go to his or her address). He or she would be an (Independent associate member).

Adult Member, 55, or over gets Senior rate = \$10.00.

Adult Senior Couple join for \$13.00. ( And your grandchildren 6 to 17 are still \$5.00, as (associate members). I know you won't forget the grandkids.

That's it. Sorry for any confusion there has been. The by-laws can be viewed on our website, and they will also spell out everything for you. Go under "Contact Officers".

Below the Officers list will be the By-Laws. It would be good for any of you to familiarize yourself to make sure we're operating as we are supposed to. In a Democratic Manner.

Majority rules. That's why I keep telling you, it's your club, I just chair it.

Come to the meeting. We're back at Serrecchio's Family Restaurant for April, May, & June. Then we should invite the restaurant folks to join us at Liberty Park, in North Jackson, as our guests, and let us serve them for a change. It'd be a nice gesture.
