HERB SCOTT PASSES AWAY

Late Model legend HERB SCOTT of Wexford, Pa passed away Thursday May 6th after a brief illness. He began racing in 1948 and won his 1st feature at New Kensington that year and won his 520th feature at Latrobe in 1979. He drove roadsters, Modifieds, Sprints and made his mark in Late Models winning the PRA title from 1956-1960 and also 62,65, and 67. Herb has been inducted into the West Pa Sports hall of fame, the Pocono RoC hall of fame, and was the Dapper Dan award winner in Pittsburgh in 57,60, and 63. In 2008 he was inducted into the National dirt track hall of fame.. His son Deek ran semi lates, Modifieds, and Late models in the 70s and 80s.
