Now 87 years old, he can now enjoy victories by his great-grandson, Jake Eucker who is a candidate for rookie/dirt. One of last year's inductees, Ralph Quarterson, won many races, driving for his father-in-law, Tom Felicetty. Bob McCann is a name that everybody knows, but did you realize he has driven nearly everything except a mini stock during his career. (and yes he drove a sprint) Does any of us oldtime fans think of the famous Emig #1 without mentioning the brilliance of builder Paul Krauss?
